GAINESVILLE—(AP)—About 15 leading citizens from Hall, Gwinnett, Forsyth and Fulton Counties will meet at Lawrenceville tonight to discuss the proposed Buford Dam.

The men will discuss problems concerning each group as regards the construction of the dam. The purpose of the meeting is for each group to acquaint the other groups with the effects of the dam on their section.
